



Please can all adults and over 12s coming on to the school site, wear a mask (except those with medical exemption).

You must maintain social distancing between different households.

Please do not arrive at school before your time slot but *during* it.

We still have far too many people arriving early and having to queue. I know I keep repeating this but it is a very big concern as there is simply not enough space in front of school for people to socially distance safely.



As we are in lockdown and children are not able to play outside or meet with friends, we are conscious that social media and online games become a method they use to keep up with what their friends are doing. Sadly, this can cause more upset as children say things they would never normally say from the security of their own home. Writing a message doesn't seem so real when they can not see the person they are sending it to. Please monitor your child's time, activities and conversations online to ensure they are safe and being safe. A reminder that all the social media apps are not for primary school children and they should not be running their own accounts. If you have any concerns, go to our Online safety page of the webpage for help and support plus contact links if you need to report online abuse.

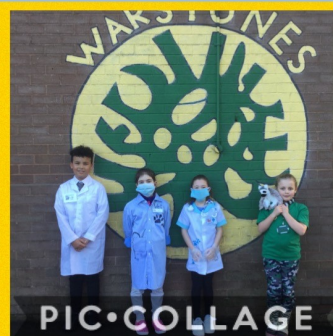
If you are worried that you do not have internet access for Purple Mash should your child go into isolation—don't worry. We will still be able to send paper copies of work to do home. Thanks to the responses to our survey earlier this term, we generally know who needs this form of remote learning.

If any member of your household has symptoms of the virus you must not enter the school site. By law, that person must self isolate for 10 days from the start of symptoms, if there have been no symptoms but a positive test result you should isolate for 10 days from the result. You may return to school on day 11 if there has not been a high temperature for 48 hours and that person has been well. Others in the household should self isolate for 14 days from the positive persons symptoms starting or if someone begins with symptoms during this time, they should isolate for a further 10 days from the onset of these. If you do have symptoms and find yourself struggling to get a test after 5 days, the advice is to just isolate for 10 days or longer until feel well again.

A reminder that if your child has a medical appointment during the day they can not come back into school afterwards, as they are more at risk of bringing the virus into school. Do try and get any appointments out of school hours, if you can.

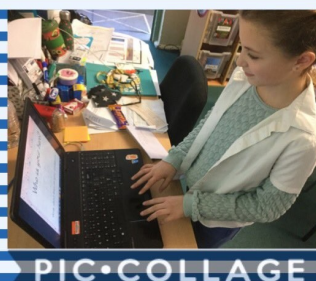
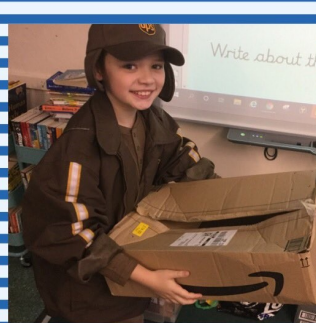
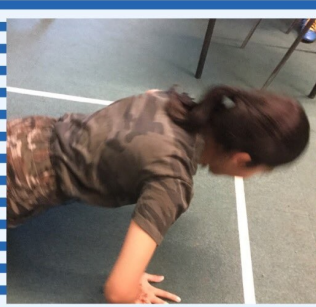
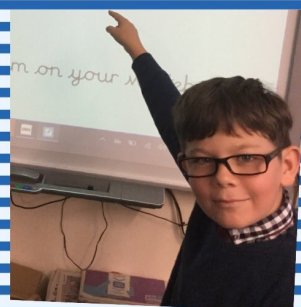


Here are some of our 'Heroes' in school today!
