Merry Christmas to all our families and friends

We are almost there! The end of our first vaguely normal term for a long time. It was a rocky start with so many COVID absences in staff and children in September, it did not feel like term got started till nearly half term. Now we face another surge in the pandemic and although it is unlikely they will close schools again, who knows what changes to guidance will occur over the Christmas break.

If there is any change to the current Tuesday 4th January start or whether there are any restrictions put in place as to who comes in, I assure you we will publish them on the webpage. If you are in any doubt as the return to school date gets nearer, just check in at www.warstonesprimary.uk and there will be a ticker tape message across the screen if there are any changes. We will also send e mails and messages but I know for some reason not everyone gets these or notifications do not always show. As it is, we are seeing a rise in cases in school and we are very stretched for staff in places. Please bear with us if messages are not replied to as quickly as we would like to. Everyone is at full stretch. I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the staff for their diligence, perseverance and dedication at such a difficult time and when worried for their own health and their families. I am so immensely proud and grateful to them.

We hope those who were able to come to the productions we have done enjoyed them. I am sorry if some of you were unable to come due to the restrictions but they are being filmed so all can enjoy. We want to carry on with these productions in the light of the new guidance but can only do so if we stick rigidly to the restrictions we put in place.

Please help us by wearing a mask, not filming during the production and remembering it is one adult per child, no younger siblings or pushchairs (unless breastfeeding with child being in arms not a pram).

It is just so good to be able to give the children the opportunity to perform live again - making memories! We can only do this with your help and support.

Can all adults coming on to the school site please wear a mask, even when walking around the one way system unless exempt.

Please e mail, telephone or leave written messages rather than try to engage with staff at doors and gates.

If your child is ill in any way, please consider a PCR test before returning to school. Children should only return to school once they have been well for 48 hours.
