Start and End of the Day!

In September, our Early Years children started last as they were new to school and needed more time to settle in, however this time, we are bringing in EY first, at their original times. Other times are as close to the previous return times as possible.

<u>Families with more than one child in different year groups</u>. In September siblings came at the later time but missed teaching time. Now, with EY coming in first, siblings can arrive with the *earliest* child and so before their start time. They can then join their cohorts at the right start time and not miss anything at all. This can apply to any siblings, not just those with EY children.

<u>Arrive at any time within your 10 minute time slot,</u> not before. There should be no need for any queuing if siblings come in together at the earliest child's time. If you arrive early because of transport (buses or taxis), please wait away from the school gates—use the space on the green by the shops.

<u>It is even more vital that you do not arrive late.</u> If you are unavoidably held up, please phone the school office when you arrive and they will tell you which door to take your child to, to be let in. Please be aware that when a child is late someone has to break their bubble to let them in, or leave children unattended to open the door. So it is important that children do arrive on time.

At pick up time we will take siblings to the hall to avoid parents having to walk round twice. Please pick up at the latest time one of your children is due so the others will be in the hall ready to be collected. However, if you would prefer to pick up children at the right time and walk round twice (especially those with children in KS1 and EY), you are still welcome to do this. Please confirm this with your teacher so we do not send them to the hall.

<u>Please remember to wear a mask and stay socially distanced from each other while walking round school.</u> It is especially important at the end of the day to ensure your children stay by your side and do not mix with other families bubbles. Only one adult should be walking round the school at drop off or pick up. Any older siblings no longer at the school, should wait outside the school gates. EY and KS1 parents will be pleased to know that the path around the back of the school has been resurfaced so it is much safer for walking on.

In EY, Lunchtime pick ups will be at 11.30am and drop offs will be 12.30pm, as normal.

Parents of children in Y1 and Y2 who have siblings in EY, Y2,3, and/or 4 and would like their children taken to the KS2 hall at the end of the day so they can be picked up at the later time of the oldest child, need to confirm this with the teachers.

Mornings (Any siblings arriving early need to walk up the KS2 path to the hall with their older siblings (no parents please). Staff will be around to help especially with the young children. EY/KS1 top gate (only one parent walking round) KS2 middle pedestrian gate (children only)

E.g. If you have children in Nursery, Y2 and Y5—all arrive at 8.30am, parent walk Nursery child round while Y2 and Y5 child enter through KS2 gate and walk to hall. At pick up, the Y5 and Y2 child can be waiting in the KS2 hall to be picked up at 3.30 when the parent walks round to pick up Nursery child.

If you have a child in Y1 and Reception, you can arrive at 8:40 and walk around with the Y1 child and a staff member will take the Reception child into the hall for you, or you can walk around twice to drop both off at their class times. At pick up, you could collect your Y1 child from the hall after picking up your Reception child at 3:20 or walk around twice to pick at their designated times.
