The number of children late to school in the morning is becoming of increasing concern and the Attendance Officer from the Local Authority is now monitoring this very closely. Please remember **KS1 and KS2** children enter school from 8.35 to **8.45 at the latest! Reception** from 8.45 till **8.55 at the latest. Doors are shut at this time as staff need to be in class to teach straight away.** If you arrive after this, children **MUST** be signed in by an adult at the office and KS1 or EY children walked round to the appropriate door by the adult. We will be calling parents of children who are late, especially if they arrive without an adult to sign in, to see if there is a problem we can help with. Please can I remind parents to stay polite to the Office staff when signing in (see below). It is not their fault if you are inconvenienced. All of this can be avoided by arriving within the 10 minute slot. Thank you.



*Our staff have the right to be treated with dignity and respect at all times. They should be able to do their jobs without being physically or verbally abused.
