We are planning Sports days in year groups split over the day to avoid large groups of parents. We hope we can have parents but that will depend on guidance at the time. Working together, helping each other!

As the need for full COVID testing has diminished, the move is towards everyone being able to do Lateral Flow tests at home. We are aiming to be a distribution hub so families in our community can collect the free tests without having to travel far. We will be open twice a week, at the FaF door, exiting out the black doo. You will need to leave details and contact information when you do. We will let you know when we start.

St Michael's Church have been running a foodbank throughout lockdown. They have asked if we would like to participate in distributing food, so we are now going to run a food collection point at the same time as the Covid test collection times. Anyone is welcome to come and have some food, there will be no checks or referrals needed. The food is there, please bring a bag and take some if you need it. You don't have to be collecting a test kit and you can come as often as you like. Simply come in at the FaF door and walk round to the black door exit and the food will be spread on tables at the exit.

It has been difficult for everyone over this last year and sometimes it can feel difficult to know how to cope and where to turn to for help. People living in the Black Country now have easier access to a specialist mental health helpline with the introduction of a new freephone number. The NHS mental health crisis helpline is run by Black Country Healthcare NHS Foundation Trust and is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is open to people of all ages – including children and young people.

Ring Freephone 0800 008 6516 (Option 1 -Sandwell/Wolverhampton. Option 2 - Dudley/Walsall) if you are feeling unable to cope or need to speak to someone urgently. It is manned by specialist mental health staff who can provide advice, support and signposting.
