PLEASE name all pieces of uniform— most children have new uniform at the beginning of the year so it is impossible to find owners of lost property if they are not named. As the weather is hot this week, many will be taking jumpers off so this will be a problem. A reminder as well, that children will need a names water bottle, especially in this current heatwave!

Please can children wear their PE Uniform to school on the days suggested below. I use the word uniform as it is just as important that they wear the correct PE attire as it is for them to wear their school uniform. Please ensure children have a white T shirt, black shorts, plimsolls and for outdoor games (and to wear to and from school over their PE uniform), a dark or school green tracksuit and trainers. Plimsolls can be left in school in a small named bag during the term to use.

Some health and safety reminders:

Please do not let children play on the air raid shelter mound at the front of school at the start and end of the day as we can not be assured it is safe.

No children should be playing on the KS2 climbing and gym equipment at the end of the day. This is especially important regarding EY and KS1 children, as the equipment is not appropriate for their size and age group, so not safe for them to use.

Breakfast Club children should all be signed in by an adult. Please DO NOT USE the car park to walk up to the hall—staff are arriving and there have been several near misses as small children are difficult to see.

Any Y6 children walking to and from school on their own MUST return the letter giving parental permission. ONLY THESE CHILDREN can bring a mobile phone to school which should be handed in to the Y6 staff, to be locked away at the start of the day.
