

Flashback/ILP Targets

Each lesson begins with the 'White Rose Flashback 4' slides that include 4 questions of previous knowledge (and a bonus 5th question!)

This should be completed on whiteboards and could be a task for once the Date and Can I have been written into books.

Children with ILPs can be working on their targets at this point either with support or independently.

Extension/Challenge

An activity for children to complete back on whiteboards, either as an extension or as an extra challenge to deepen their understanding. This may even be a snapshot of the learning for the next day.

Maths lesson structure

Arithmetic

A short burst of questions, usually differentiated with chillis, for the children to complete on their whiteboards. This focuses on the four operations (using methods that have been previously taught) and place value areas. It can also include fractions and multiplication table practice.

Application

A chance for children to apply their new learning. This may be through differentiated activities in books (using chillies), games or group activities that encourage collaboration. Children will be given the opportunity to independently choose the level of work that they will complete, being able to change challenges if they feel it is too easy or too hard.

Recap

A quick recap of the previous lesson's learning that will be built upon further in the lesson.

After recap, any Pink for Think or previous misconceptions can be addressed.

If starting a new unit, the recap will be from the last time the skill was taught (which may be in the previous year group).

Teach

The teaching of the new learning, which will be modelled by the teacher. In this section, the children will be given opportunities to practise, using differentiated questions, on whiteboards with worked examples displayed for them to follow.
